AIR PERMITTING PORTABLE & STATIONARY EQUIPMENT

Is it possible to obtain an air permit for equipment to operate at one location continuously with the flexibility to move all or part of the equipment to other locations as needed? That was the question one of our clients posed for their rock crushing operation in Washington. Spring Environmental worked with the Eastern Regional office of the Washington Department of Ecology to develop a permit that would do just that. The permit covers over 80 pieces of equipment or 11 plants that can operate as an individual unit, or together for larger operations. Two stationary diesel-fired generators triggered a second-tier health impact analysis for diesel engine particulate matter. This project resulted in a single air permit that simplifies compliance requirements while maintaining the greatest operational flexibility!

Stormwater Discharge Under EPA's Construction General Permit

Controlling stormwater discharge from construction sites is difficult at the best of times but poses extra challenges on a military airstrip. Spring Environmental recently consulted with ACME Concrete Paving to develop a Notice of Intent and corresponding Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan to properly control stormwater during construction of Joint Base Lewis-McChord's runway repair projects.
